New development projects submitted to the City are sent to one or more of four groups for approval.



Step 2 | Project Review

Next, projects are reviewed based on their type.

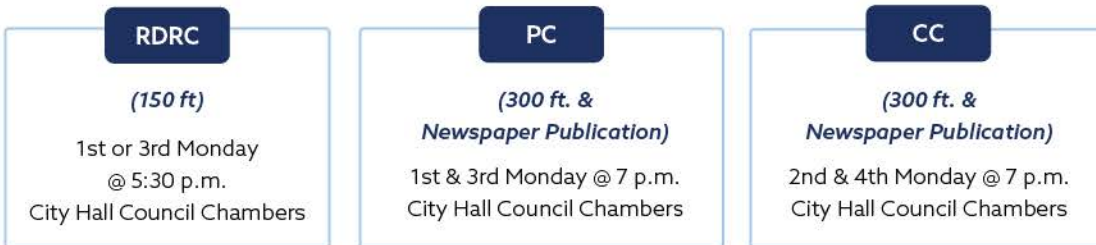

Neighborhood Outreach

Neighborhood outreach is conducted to all community members in the immediate vicinity of a new project (either a 150 ft. or 300 ft. radius). Project details and information on any public meetings are given.



ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Larger development projects require an Environmental Impact Review (EIR), which is circulated for public viewing and comment.

Step 4 | Community Feedback & Involvement

Community members can become involved in the process of new developments and share their feedback with the City. A Public Hearing is conducted to discuss the new project at an RDRC, PC, or CC meeting. Any interested community members are invited to attend. or provide written comments via email or letter.
