













Homelessness and Life Expectancy

 Homeless persons 3-4x more likely to die prematurely vs housed persons

Homeless Average Life Expectancy: 43-54 years vs U.S. Life
 Expectancy 76.6 years in 2021



Cost of Homelessness: Santa Clara County

- Medical, mental health, drug and alcohol, judicial data for 104,206 individuals experiencing homelessness in Santa Clara County from 2007-2012
 - 13% Persistently homeless
- Total cost to community: \$520 million/year



Cost of Homelessness: Santa Clara County

- Homeless costs heavily skewed towards frequent users
 - Average annual cost per person:
 - All county residents experiencing homelessness (2012): \$5,148
 - Individuals with costs in top 5% (2012): > \$100,000
 - Top 5% accounted for 47% of all costs to community
 - 2,800 Persistently homeless residents: \$83,000

Homelessness

- Lack of housing is traumatizing and significantly shortens an individual's life expectancy.
- People experiencing homelessness are at a greater risk of infectious diseases and chronic illness, poor mental health, and substance use issues.
- Most researchers agree that the connection between homelessness and mental illness is a complicated, two-way relationship.

Homelessness and mental health

- Mental illness, in addition to adverse childhood experiences and substance use, are risk factors for homelessness.
- Homelessness in turn has been associated with inferior mental health outcomes.
- Depression, PTSD, schizophrenia, anxiety disorders and substance use disorders are among the most common types of mental health issues in the homeless population.

Homelessness and mental health

- Everyone's reasons for homelessness are unique. Yet if there's any one common denominator, it's the **experience of trauma**.
- And trauma can be layered on top of trauma, on top of trauma- individual who is experiencing **complex trauma**.

Homelessness and mental health

- Understanding trauma and understanding the behaviors that are a normal reaction to trauma is important.
- Important to provide trauma informed care:
 - Seeing people through the lens of not "what's wrong with you," but "what happened to you?"

Impact of Homelessness on mental health

- Fundamental basic human needs i.e., access to food, water, and shelter often take priority over seeking psychiatric care which is often not addressed until a crisis occurs.
- May continue to experience various forms of physical, sexual, and emotional trauma.
- Homeless individuals may have experienced traumatic brain injuries, and cognitive impairment

Impact of Homelessness on mental health

- Homeless individual often lack access to health care treatment.
- More likely to use hospitals/ER which is not only more expensive but results in fragmented care.
- Addressing medical care needs may take priority over psychiatric care.
- Lack of dependable Transportation
- Lack of dependable Communication

Homelessness to Recovery

- Recovery
- Major dimensions that support a life in recovery include:
 - Health
 - > Home
 - Purpose
 - Community

Examples of Homeless Settings for Students

- Shared housing due to economic hardship
- Motels or hotels
- Public or private spaces not designed for sleeping
- Trailer parks or campgrounds
- Cars, parks, and abandoned buildings
- Shelters
- Emergency or transitional shelters

Barriers to Learning



- Lack of access to services
 - Getting basic needs met
 - Immunizations
 - Language translation
 - Transportation
 - Enrollment challenges

System Barriers

- Lack of accurate identification of students who are eligible for support under McKinney-Vento
- Lack of support connecting parents to essential services
- Lack of outreach to unaccompanied youth
- Lack of Before and After School care

School Challenge: Underreporting

- Definitions are confusing and misunderstood
- Schools are understaffed to match the needs
- If students are not identified, services are not provided

Solution: Identification must be improved

1,746 Students 2018-19



6.1% of SED Pop 2012-19

Academic Protections

- Immediate enrollment regardless of records
- Preschoolers may receive priority enrollment
- Remaining in "School of Origin" the school last attended when permanently housed
- Must be provided transportation to and from school of origin
- Have equal access to instructional programs
- Protected from sigma or segregation

McKinney-Vento School Funding and Partnerships

Funding:

- Purchasing backpacks filled with hygiene and school supplies
- Provide transportation for students
- Fund afterschool and other extracurricular programs

Funds to Partners:

- Preschools and Head Start programs to support families
- Lifemoves to support academic tutoring and other after school
- Support Samaritan House to support food insecurity needs



Evaluate Needs

- ✓ Register for food supports, such as Grocery Pantry, Dining Room, Mobile Meals, etc.
- ✓ Assess and refer to other SH Programs, such as CES, Kids Closet, medical & dental care, etc.
- ✓ Information and referral to partner agencies
- ✓ Assess and determine eligibility for financial assistance, such as late rent, deposits, mortgage, utilities, car repairs, etc.



Case Management Services

Screening Questions:

- o Resident of San Mateo County?
- o City of Residence?
- O What is your critical need?

Application Check List:

- Demographic Information: Household members, address, ages, ethnicity, language, monthly income, veteran status, etc.
- o Proof of Identification for each member of the household (i.e. picture ID, birth certificate, Social Security, etc.)
- Employment Verification for past 30 days (i.e. recent paycheck stubs)
- Other Income Verification (i.e. letters or statements from CalWorks, Child Support, Social Security, Unemployment, Employment offer letter)
- o Bank Statements for the last month
- Rental/Lease Agreement or Mortgage Statement
- Verification of critical need:
 - Eviction notice, notice of delinquent rent, 3 day pay or quit or statements from other members of shared situation.
 - · Utility bills for the past month and/or shut off notice
 - · Car repair estimate (: must also include auto registration, auto insurance and driver's license of owner
 - ❖ For Covid-related cases: Documents include EDD, medical paperwork, letter from employer, letter from Housingiskey.com, etc.
- Any additional documentation deemed necessary to demonstrate the client's situation or need for assistance.
